

Educator Application instructions and festival logistics

Deadline for applications: July 1, 2018

Due to increased size and complexity of the Festival, educators must submit an application to participate and spaces will be assigned.

If you are sharing a tent with other educators please indicate this on the application. However, if you are open to sharing and have not already coordinated with other organizations we will place with appropriate organizations. If you can only participate one day, please let us know and we will accommodate your organization. However, we do request your booth remain open between 10am and 6pm each day. You may stay open later if you desire, as the festival will be open until after 8pm.

This year we will hand out passports to encourage guests to visit our education booths. Please come to the festival prepared with a question or quest your booth visitor must complete to get their passport stamped. If guests fill out a passport they will receive raffle tickets that will get them in a drawing for prizes. If you have any items to donate to the raffle they would be welcome. The prizes will be for 3 different age groups (adults 21 and over, teen 16-20, and youth).

Spaces: Spaces will be assigned. Please go directly to the Volunteer/Vendor/Educator check-in booth. On-site staff will be available during set-up times to assist in finding your space.

Parking/Camping: There is a separate Staff/Vendor/educator parking area, please let the attendants know you are and educator so you get parking that is closer to the booths. Parking passes will be handed out at the check-in booth. Vendors and educators may camp on the Festival grounds, but if not in a designated camping spot, must have all gear removed prior to opening each day. Security: Several security guards will be on Festival grounds Friday through Sunday, but we cannot guarantee safety of your booth. Please take appropriate precautions when closing for the night.
